Please complete the online placement test at least 4 weeks before your arrival. The results will be communicated to you in our school.

Courses start every Monday. You will be placed in an ongoing course at your level. German courses for beginners start every month.

#### **GOOD TO KNOW**

#### Punctuality

Class begins punctually at the scheduled time. Participants who do not arrive punctually may not join the class until the next break. Please respect your classmates and teachers.

#### **Public Holidays**

Lessons canceled due to public holidays will be canceled without replacement. Individual lessons are always rescheduled. There are no lessons during school holidays.

#### Vacation requests

If you attend a course that lasts longer than 20 weeks, you can request a leave of absence of 2 weeks. You must submit the vacation application 2 weeks before the planned vacation. Only then can we ensure that you can make up for the course weeks you missed. Please note that you will have to develop the course content yourself as your current course will continue.

Please bring €20 in cash as refundable deposit to receive the key card to be able to enter the building.

<sup>\*</sup> During periods of peak capacity it may be that the normal morning sessions will be held in the afternoons from 14:30 pm - 17:45 pm instead. In such cases, class is typically held three times a week in the morning and twice a week in the afternoon, or vice versa. Timetable subject to changes.

#### **Exam Preparation**

The preparation takes place in the afternoon over 3 to 4 weeks:

- telc 20 lessons per course
- Goethe 18 lessons per course
- TestDaF 40 lessons per course

#### Level test

At the end of the course level you must pass the test with 60% to be moved to the next level.

#### Exams

You can take the following exams for an additional fee:

- telc Deutsch B, telc Deutsch B2
- telc C1 Hochschule
- TestDaF (paper based)

#### Certificate

You will receive a certificate of completion if you have passed the internal level test.

#### Teaching Material

You can buy teaching materials at school. You will need one textbook every 3-4 weeks. The cost is approximately  $\le 20- \le 25$  per book. Payment is made by card at school.

#### Participation Certificate

You will receive a certificate of participation if you can demonstrate at least 80% attendance.

#### Arriva

You can book a pickup from the airport or main train station through a transfer company. Please refer to the company's terms and conditions in your confirmation in case you're delayed.



#### Taxi

It's cheaper to take a taxi from the airport to the city. You can usually only pay for taxis in cash. You can order a taxi or Uber using the app and pay a fixed rate through the app.



#### Public transport

Once you arrive, you will quickly notice that it is very easy to get around using public transport. You can find ticket information and prices at machines or in the local provider app.

#### Host Family

You will receive your accommodation confirmation in good time before your arrival. Inform your hosts of your arrival time by email/phone at least a week prior to your arrival so they know your arrival time and are home then.

#### Youth Hotel

You will receive a hotel voucher before your arrival. You will find a booking number on this. Please do not make any payments to the hotel directly, as payment for your room was made via did deutsch-insitut.

#### Student Residence

A did employee will greet you at the residence and hand over the keys. If you have not yet agreed on a fixed checkin date, please contact us urgently one week before arrival and provide your arrival details and contacts.
